

Advisory Board Qualifications and Duties

Qualifications of Advisory Board member:

- Must be a person of faith and reflects such faith in his or her speech, conduct and service.
- Must be an innovative global strategic thinker
- Must be an experienced person of influence in a certain sphere of society.
- Must be willing to support TFU in his/her own capacities of time, talent and treasure

Duties of TFU Advisory Board:

- Required to attend quarterly TFU Advisory Board meetings (by Zoom)
- Be open and available for advice/strategy as needed
- Keep confidential any information discussed in Advisory Board meetings
- Are not required to give financially to TFU

Limitations of TFU Advisory Board:

The Advisory Board members are not directors of TFU, and as such are not counted for the purposes of determining a quorum, may not vote on any matters brought before the Executive Board of TFU, have no right to request a special meeting of the Board of Directors, and do not have any other rights, privileges, or duties of an Executive Board Director.

The TFU Executive Board of Directors may suspend an Advisory Board member's service if the member's conduct is deemed misconduct.

Misconduct will include:

- Disrespectful behavior to other advisory board or executive members, or any member of The Foundation United
- Inappropriate sexual advances to other advisory board or executive members, or any member of The Foundation United
- Monopolizing board meetings
- Failure to attend two or more meetings of the advisory board within one year
- Failure to handle confidential information securely
- Pursuing a personal agenda
- Convicted of a crime
